Electric Vehicle Charger Rebate Program

Georgia Power residential customers may qualify for a \$250 rebate for each new Residential charger purchased and installed.

Eligibility requirements:

- Must be a Georgia Power customer
- ≥ 208/240-volt Level 2 charger with dedicated circuit
- Single-family homes
- Third-party vendors or EV charging businesses not eligible
